

**Appendix B**  
**The Plan of Care Summary**

The Plan of Care Summary helps to organize the planning process for prescribers, providers, and children and families. The Plan of Care Summary represents a visual overview of the diagnosis and individualized clinical interventions for each child receiving wraparound mental health services. These interventions are divided into 4 categories:

1. Mental health services funded through the MA outpatient fee schedule, effective December 1, 1993, for individuals under 21 years of age.
2. Other mental health services already on the MA outpatient fee schedule before December 1, 1993.
3. Expanded mental health services requested by MA 325 Applications.
4. Community services and resources, including services provided by other child-serving systems.

In completing the Plan of Care Summary, list first any newly developed, wraparound mental health services requested by an 1150 Waiver Request, (MA 325) placing an asterisk in front of each of these. Next, list all mental health services utilized from the outpatient MA fee schedule. Then list those community interventions and multiple agency services such as planned educational interventions, the specific roles of Children and Youth Services, Juvenile Justice, etc., including the case manager.
