#### **Abstract:**

The network of the Department of Human Services (DHS) has gateways to other networks. A standard is needed regarding gateways from the DHS network to proprietary networks.

#### **General:**

The purpose of this document is to provide a standard regarding DHS network gateways to proprietary networks.

#### **Standard:**

Gateways to proprietary networks are **not** permitted unless explicitly authorized by the DHS network manager (Chief, Network Architecture and Telecommunication Management Unit).

#### **Exemptions from this Standard:**

Exceptions to this standard will be granted only in situations where the cost of open systems connections is deemed prohibitive.

#### **Refresh Schedule:**

All standards and referenced documentation identified in this standard will be subject to review and possible revision annually or upon request by the DHS Information Technology Standards Team.
