#### **Abstract:**

The Department of Human Services (DHS) networks, like all business networks, must be properly managed.

#### **General:**

The purpose of this document is to provide a standard against proprietary network management systems at DHS and to provide a standard for connectivity devices on the DHS network.

#### **Standard:**

No proprietary network management systems are permitted under the DHS network.

All connectivity devices must be Simple Network Management Protocol (SNMP) network manageable.

#### **Exemptions from this Standard:**

There will be no exemptions to this standard.

#### **Refresh Schedule:**

All standards and referenced documentation identified in this standard will be subject to review and possible revision annually or upon request by the DHS Information Technology Standards Team.
