



Who Qualifies for Pennsylvania's HealthChoices Medicaid Coverage?

The following individuals may qualify for Medical Assistance in Pennsylvania:

Children:

- Children up to and including 20 years old

Adults:

- Adults up to and including age 64 at or below 138% FPL
- Pregnant Women
- Some women with breast and/or cervical cancer

Older Adults and Individuals with Disabilities:

- Adults aged 65 and older
- People with disabilities, including blindness as determined under the Social Security rules

Refugees and Immigrants:

- Lawfully present immigrants may be eligible for Medicaid

To be eligible for coverage, you must:

1. Be a U.S. citizen or meet Medicaid immigration status requirements. Your local county assistance office can help to explain these requirements and can help get you enrolled.
2. Have or get a Social Security number.
3. Be a Pennsylvania resident.
4. Meet certain financial requirements.

Please Note: Financial requirements vary depending on the program. Some people who are elderly, blind or disabled may have too high an income to qualify for Medicaid. In this case, you may have a spend down plan that allows you to qualify on a month-by-month basis. If you are an older adult or an individual with a disability, you may need to meet a resource requirement to qualify.
