


HealthChoices Expansion

What does this mean for recipients?

- Medicaid recipients in Healthy, Healthy Plus and the Private Coverage Option (PCO) will be transitioned into one Adult benefit package.
- The health screening tool will be eliminated.



Adult

No coverage will be immediately impacted.

When will the transition occur?

Spring 2015

- Individuals receiving Medical Assistance as of December 2014 moved to the Adult benefit package
- Coverage delivered through the HealthChoices physical and behavioral health program
- Health screen eliminated as part of the initial determination of benefit package
- Admission of newly eligible adults into the PCO ends

There will be no gaps in coverage.

When will the transition occur?

Summer/Fall 2015

- All individuals in the PCO transitioned into the Adult benefit package delivered through the HealthChoices physical and behavioral health program
- Raise Your Hand process ends

Fall 2015

- Traditional Medicaid expansion will be complete
- Final termination of the 1115 waiver
- Premiums not implemented

There will be no gaps in coverage.

▶ What changes now?

Nothing changes immediately.

- Continue to complete the health screening tool
- The Raise Your Hand process is still in place
- Individuals will be notified prior to any changes taking place
