

Policy Communiqué #11-01 Regulated Out-of-State Providers/Verification of Legal Operation

Title: Regulated Out-of-State Providers/Verification of Legal Operation

Purpose:

The Office of Child Development and Early Learning (OCDEL) is issuing this communiqué to remind Child Care Information Services (CCIS) agencies to conduct the annual canvas of regulated out-of-state providers currently serving Pennsylvania children and verify that they are operating legally as a child care provider.

Background:

On an annual basis, the CCIS must contact out-of-state providers serving subsidy children to obtain updated provider information and confirm the facility continues to operate legally within the appropriate state. Please refer to the Attachments - "Verification of Legal Operations Letter", "Regulated Out-of-State Provider Child Care Facility Information" and "Federal Tax Information" to review the process and paperwork required for out-of-state regulated providers.

Discussion:

The CCIS must forward providers' information to OCDEL. Please follow the steps below to complete this verification process.

The CCIS must:

- Identify out-of-state regulated providers currently participating in Pennsylvania's subsidized child care program.
- **By January 21, 2011**, send the attached provider letter and forms to out-of-state regulated providers with instructions to return the completed documents to the CCIS **by February 18, 2011**.
- Terminate the agreement and suspend any enrollments for any out-of-state regulated provider that does not return the information by that date.
- **By February 25, 2011**, forward the updated information to:

- 2.) Send request for updated information to regulated out-of-state providers currently participating in Pennsylvania's subsidized child care program by January 21, 2011.
- 3.) Forward updated information to Kathy Seidl at the above address by February 25, 2011.
- 4.) Terminate agreements and suspend any enrollments for out-of-state providers that do not comply.
