### Field names and Details

1	COUNTY	County Code
2	COUNTYNAME	Name of the County
3	OFFICE	Office Code

5	WORKLOAD	Workload for the Case

7	STATUS	Eligibility status for the case (ELI - Eligible, INE -Ineligible)
8	PROGRAM	Current child care program (LI - Low income , FT - Former TANF, HS - Head Start, FS - Food Stamps, TF -TANF)
9	ACTIVITY	Activity type for the case (Paid, Unpaid or No Activity). This field will have values only for the TANF program.

No	Tab name	Description
1	Co-pay Decreases	<p>This sheet lists cases for which the 2008 co-pay is lower than the current co-pay in the system. For these cases, there are 2 options.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Run and confirm eligibility after xx/xx/2008. The system will automatically asses the new co-pay.</li></ol> <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>2. Manually override the co-pay effective xx/xx/2008. Note that co-pay stabilization rules will be applied for future effective co-pay will apply if eligibility is run before xx/xx/2008.</li></ol>
2	Override Co-pay Decreases	<p>This sheet lists cases for which the 2008 co-pay is lower than the current co-pay in the system AND the calculated 2007 co-pay is different from the current co-pay in the system. The difference between the 2007 co-pay and the current co-pay in the system could be attributed to co-pay override or to co-pay stabilization. We recommend that each case on this list be individually examined since the high current co-pay may be for collection/recoupment purposes.</p>
