IMPORTANT REMINDER: All providers must revalidate the Medical Assistance (MA) enrollment of each service location every 5 years. Providers should log into PROMISE to check the revalidation dates of each service location and submit revalidation applications at least 60 days prior to the revalidation dates. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Medical Assistance (MA) Bulletin is to advise providers that the Department of Human Services (Department) is end-dating three procedure codes related to the COVID-19 specimen collection by pharmacies and testing by laboratories, effective with dates of service on and after May 12, 2023.

SCOPE:

This bulletin applies to pharmacies, clinics and laboratories enrolled in the MA Program who render services to MA beneficiaries in the fee-for-service delivery system. Providers rendering services to MA beneficiaries in the managed care delivery system should contact the appropriate managed care organization with any coding or billing questions.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

On April 13, 2020, Pennsylvania's Department of State issued guidance that granted licensed pharmacists the authority to order, administer tests, and communicate results for COVID-19 tests. In response, the Department added the COVID-19 specimen collection procedure code G2023 to the MA Program Fee Schedule to be used for collection of the COVID-19 specimen by a licensed pharmacist. This guidance is no longer in effect as of the end of the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE) and therefore the procedure code was end-dated, for dates of service on and after May 12, 2023.

On April 14, 2020, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) announced the creation of two new laboratory procedure codes to provide a higher payment for use of high-throughput technologies for increased testing capacity for the COVID-19 PHE. In response, the Department added procedure codes U0003 and U0004 to the MA Program Fee Schedule, to be used for laboratory testing to detect the SARS-CoV-2 virus. At the end of the COVID-19 PHE, these procedure codes were end-dated, for dates of service on and after May 12, 2023. Outpatient clinics and laboratories can continue to bill for laboratory testing for COVID-19 with procedure codes U0001 or U0002.

PROCEDURE:

The Department is end-dating the following procedure codes from the MA Program Fee Schedule, effective with dates of service on and after May 12, 2023:
