


### CHC Statewide Monthly Enrollments by MCO




### CHC Market Share Chart





#### CHC Market Share by Population Group




The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population with 62%. The percentage of HCBS participants increased in July to 26% from 25% in June and the LTC population decreased from 13% of the population to 12%.

### Medicare Type for All CHC Recipients by Zone



In July, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained at 8.3%. The percentage of participants in both aligned and unaligned D-SNPs increased slightly. The percentage of participants with FFS Medicare decreased slightly (0.3%). Medicare advantage participation increased by 0.1%.


### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan


### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan


### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage



### Other OLTL Program Enrollment




