End of Continuous Coverage Unwinding

 - Available at www.dhs.pa.gov/staycovered
 - All data is at the individual level and filterable by:
 - County
 - Zip Code
 - Age
 - Baselevel data available
 - Two new unwinding metrics available through the end of April
 - Continuous coverage for the Medicaid maintained population
 - Monthly enrollment status changes for the entire Medicaid population
 - Data will be refreshed monthly

The Post-Renewal Process & Notices

- Following renewal processing, a household will receive a notice indicating if individuals in the household are still eligible or no longer eligible for Medicaid coverage or CHIP at their current cost level.
- If individuals continue to be eligible at renewal, a notice will be sent indicating that the individual is eligible for ongoing coverage.
- If individuals are no longer eligible, the notice will indicate the reason for ineligibility.
- Additionally, notices will include:
 - Information regarding how to request an appeal and fair hearing

DHS referrals to Pennie

- **If a person is financially ineligible for Medicaid**, their information will be sent to Pennie automatically and securely.
- Pennie will send notice (mail and/or email) with:
 - Access code to claim Pennie account
 - Estimate of financial savings
 - Enrollment Deadline – encouraging enrollment within 60 days of MA end date for no gap in coverage
- Pennie will send follow-up emails and perform outbound calls
- **If a person does not return their renewal**, their information will be sent to Pennie after their MA closes. Pennie will perform outreach based on the communication avenues shared: DHS/CHIP/Pennie Co-branded postal letter, emails, outbound calls
