



CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO






CHC Market Share Chart


The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 57.9%, this was a decrease since January. The percentage of HCBS participants increased from 31.4% to 31.8%. The LTC population remained the same at 10.3%.

Statewide LTSS Populations Plus HCBS Percentage






Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region**



In February, the statewide percentage of non-duals increased from 10.2% to 10.3%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs remained the same at 12.8%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 38.2% to 38.8%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased from 26.6% to 26.1%. Other Medicare Advantage decreased from 10.5% to 10.3%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan








DID YOU KNOW?

In February 2024, there were 8,134 participants in CHC who chose to direct their own PAS services and 469 participants in OLTL's FFS programs.



Number of Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Facilities by County






Other OLTL Program Enrollment
