<b>P-EBT Summer Benefits 3.0</b>
NSLP eligible students and students in CEP schools who were enrolled (including in-person) until the end of the 2020-2021 school year (May 2021) received an additional <b><u>\$375</u></b> for the summer of 2021. <b>Issued in September 2021</b>
*The maximum amount that could be issued to a fully virtual student who received the summer benefit is <b><u>\$1,602.60</u></b> for P-EBT 3.0.

NOTE: The maximum P-EBT amount a fully virtual student can receive in one quarter is \$426 (60 days x \$7.10 rate per day).					

**NOTE:** Instruction models will no longer be used for P-EBT 4.0. Children who are home schooled, attend a cyber charter school, or are enrolled in a school that does not participate in the NSLP will not be eligible for P-EBT. Benefits will be issued based on the number of days out due to COVID reported for each quarter multiplied by the rate of \$7.10 per day.

**P-EBT Summer Benefits 4.0**

NSLP eligible students and students in CEP schools who were enrolled (including those who missed zero days for the entire year) until the end of the 2021-2022 school year (May 2022) receive an additional **\$391** for the summer of 2022. **Issued October 2022.**

\*The maximum amount that could be issued to a fully virtual student (60 days out per quarter) who received the summer benefit is \$1,669 for P-EBT 4.0.

**Childcare P-EBT Benefit Amount Breakdown**

**NOTE:** If the child turned 6 during any of this time (DURING 3.0), the child was no longer eligible. The child will receive a pro-rated benefit up through the month in which they turned 6, but nothing beyond that.

**For example:** If the child turned 6 in April, they would receive a pro-rated Stage 3 benefit for March and April, but would not get anything for May or the Summer P-EBT.

**Childcare P-EBT 3.0 Summer Benefits**

\$375 for the period of June, July, and August 2021. **Issued October 2021**

**NOTE:** It doesn't matter which months the child was eligible for SNAP. They will receive the amount shown in the chart for the total number of months.

**Example:** John was eligible for SNAP September 2021-November 2021. John is eligible for 3 months and will receive \$141.88 in stage 1.

**Example:** Sally was eligible for SNAP November 2021-January 2022. Sally is also eligible for 3 months and will receive \$141.88 in stage 1.

During 4.0, if a child was under six when the school aged P-EBT started (so if a child was under 6 on September 1, 2021) they could qualify for the whole year, including summer, even once they turned six, provided they remained on SNAP benefits the whole time.

**NOTE:** It doesn't matter which months the child was eligible for SNAP. They will receive the amount shown in the chart for the total number of months.

**Example:** Ryan was eligible for SNAP February 2022-March 2022. Ryan is eligible for 2 months and will receive \$76.15 in stage 1.

**Example 2:** Jordan was eligible for SNAP April 2022-May 2022. Jordan is also eligible for 2 months and will receive \$76.15 in stage 1.

**P-EBT 4.0 Childcare Benefits were issued 9/29/2022**, unlike P-EBT 3.0, there will be only 2 stages of Childcare P-EBT issuances for the 2021-2022 school year, and every child will receive the same benefit amount for the number of months they were eligible for SNAP, rather than taking the average for a region as we did with P-EBT 3.0. As before, benefits were issued to the SNAP payment name's EBT card. There was no retroactive eligibility this time; the child will only get the amount shown in the chart for the number of months they were eligible for SNAP.

Stage 2 issuances are scheduled to go out on October 13 and 14. The Summer P-EBT Childcare Benefit will go out on **October 27 and 28**.

**Childcare P-EBT 4.0 Summer Benefits**

**\$391 for both school age and childcare age children.** Child will receive the summer benefit if they were eligible for SNAP in May and at least one summer month (June, July, or August) in 2022.
