## Accessing HC Extranet using Site Invitation Email

1. Once you receive the site invitation email you can click the site link within the email to access the new site.



2. After clicking the site link within the email, you should be directed to the SharePoint welcome page shown below. From here you can choose to login using an existing personal Microsoft account or by using your work email that's associated with a Microsoft account through your organization. If you don't have an email associated with a Microsoft account you can create one by clicking the "Create a Microsoft account, it's quick and easy!" link near the bottom. Note: It is possible that you may bypass the welcome screen and be directed straight to the login screen if you already have a Microsoft account associated with your email.
