APPENDIX H-4 - Regulations for a New Group Child Care Home - School Age Program

An inspection of a new facility will be conducted following submission of a complete application for a certificate of compliance. A facility in which care is provided exclusively to school-age children shall comply only with the sections specified in 55 Pa. Code §3280.221, relating to requirements specific to school-age programs. The operator of a school-age child day care facility must demonstrate compliance with the requirements outlined below in order to receive an initial provisional certificate of compliance:

If a violation is cited regarding regulatory requirements <u>other than one of those outlined above</u>, the operator must submit an acceptable plan of correction in order for a provisional certificate of compliance to be recommended.
