Medicare and Medicare Advantage Crossover Claims for Certified Registered Nurse Practitioners (CRNP) and Physician Assistants (PA)

Medicare allows Certified Registered Nurse Practitioners (CRNP) and Physician Assistants (PA) to enroll, to bill as rendering provider, and to be paid for services.

Pennsylvania Medicaid participates with Medicare in a Coordination of Benefits Agreement (COBA), which allows for Cost Sharing of Medicaid eligible services for Medicare and Medicare Advantage Crossover claims. As a result, The Department is making a PROMISe™ claims processing modification to allow payment of the recipient Cost Sharing amounts when the rendering provider type is either a CRNP or PA for Medicaid eligible services for both Medicare and Medicare Advantage claims.

This modification is currently scheduled to begin with claims processed on Friday, April 27, 2018.
