NPI & Paper Claim Forms: CMS-1500 (Professional) & UB-04 (Institutional)

CMS-1500 paper claims submitted to Medical Assistance are not considered HIPAA transactions. The 13 digit PROMISe™ legacy number should still be listed as the primary identifier. DHS requests that healthcare providers enter an NPI number as a secondary identifier. CMS 1500 paper claims will be processed based on the legacy provider number submitted on a claim.

UB-04 paper claims submitted to DHS will require the 13 digit **PROMISe™** legacy provider number as the primary identifier. DHS requests that providers enter an NPI number as a secondary identifier. UB04 claims will be processed based on the PROMISe™ legacy provider number submitted on the claim.

ADA-2006 paper claims/authorizations submitted to DHS require the 13 digit PROMISe™ legacy number of the enrolled group/corporation or organization designated to receive payment in box 52A as the primary identifier. DHS requests the NPI number of the payee be entered in box 49 as a secondary identifier. ADA-2006 claims will be processed based on the legacy number submitted in box 52A and the dental license number of the rendering provider entered in box 55.
