

Provider Files Reinstatement of PRV720 Provider Revalidation File for Behavioral, Physical Health and Community HealthChoices Update Date Issued: April 8, 2021

Background: On March 6, 2020, Governor Wolf issued an emergency disaster declaration in response to the presence of the COVID-19 (coronavirus) in Pennsylvania. The Department of Human Services (DHS) issued guidance to advise Managed Care Organizations (MCO) to accept and process claims from providers not currently enrolled in the PA Medicaid program. The PRV720 Monthly Provider Revalidation file was suspended to not create additional confusion by providing revalidation dates for providers who would remain open.

Details: The PRV720 Monthly Provider Revalidation file (PRV720M.XX.zip) will once again be provided to all MCOs on the first of each month beginning April 1, 2021.

Effective June 1, 2021, the Department will reinstate provider revalidation requirements as applicable prior to the public health emergency. The Department will work with providers to complete overdue revalidations on a monthly staggered method, as described in MA Bulletin 99-21-01 issued on March 23, 2021. Please see <u>MA Bulletin</u> <u>99-21-01</u> for specifics on the reinstatement of provider revalidation requirements.

Because of the revalidation requirement, it is necessary for the MCOs to once again receive the PRV720 file and to be able to properly communicate the revalidation dates to their respective providers.
