

# INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY SERVICES

# Pennsylvania's home- and community-based waivers administered by the Office of Developmental

**Programs** are designed to help people with intellectual disabilities, developmental disabilities, and autism live more independently in their homes and communities. These programs provide a variety of services that promote community living, including group homes, single apartments with a roommate, or a family-living setting. The mission is to assist Pennsylvanians with intellectual disabilities, developmental disabilities, and autism in achieving greater independence, choice and opportunity in their lives.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

#### **Program requirements:**

- No minimum age.
- Must have a diagnosis of an intellectual disability, developmental disability, or autism.
- Must meet appropriate level of care criteria.

#### **Financial Eligibility:**

- Meet income eligibility requirements determined by the County Assistance Office.
- \*\* Some waivers have a maximum annual expenditure per person per fiscal year, excluding certain services.

# **SERVICES THAT MIGHT BE AVAILABLE INCLUDE:**

# **Health Services**

- Behavior support
- Nursing
- Therapy (physical, occupational, behavioral, speech/language, orientation, mobility and vision therapy)

## Home Care Services

- Home and vehicle accessibility adaptations
- Homemaker/chore
- Respite

#### **Other Services**

- Assistive technology
- Companion
- Education support
- Supports coordination
- Transportation
- Case Management
- Employment services, including pre-vocational, supported employment, and transitional work services.
