

OFFICE OF LONG TERM LIVING WAIVER PROGRAMS

The Office of Long Term Living (OLTL) operates several Medicaid home and community-based services waiver programs for Pennsylvanians over the age of 18 with physical disabilities and older adults to enable them the opportunity to continue to live in, or return to, their homes and communities with a variety of supports and services. OLTL Waiver programs operated by OLTL provide an alternative to a nursing home; they allow individuals to receive services in their homes; offer a wide array of home health and personal care services; and offer people the opportunity to direct their own services.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Must meet appropriate age requirements.
- Must be a resident of Pennsylvania.
- **Must meet** the level of care requirements.
- Must be determined financially eligible for Medicaid services.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or a qualified noncitizen.
- Must have a social security number.

SERVICES THAT MIGHT BE AVAILABLE INCLUDE:

Health Services

- · Adult daily living
- Nutritional consultation
- Nursing care
- Therapy services (physical, occupational, speech, and language)
- Specialized medical equipment
- * Services provided are based on assessed needs.

Home Care Services

- Accessibility adaptations
- Personal assistance service
- Home delivered meals
- In-home respite care

Other Services

- Transportation services
- Assistive technology
- Employment related services
- Counseling services
- Service coordination
