Total CHC Enrollment 1









The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 62.1%, representing 0.1% decrease from last month. The percentage of HCBS participants increased to 27.5% which is a 0.1% increase from last month. The LTC population remains at 10.4%.




CHC Enrollments by County*

Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage








Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region**



In May, the statewide percentage of non-duals increase from 8.8% to 8.9%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased from 12.5% to 12.7%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 30.7% to 31.6%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased by 0.2% to 34.5%. Other Medicare Advantage decrease from 12.1% to 11.1%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan






D-SNP Enrollments by Plan


Number of Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Facilities by County


