







The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 61.9%, representing 0.1% decrease from last month. The percentage of HCBS participants increased to 27.6% which is a 0.1% increase from last month. The LTC population remains at 10.4%.




#### CHC Enrollments by County\*


#### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage

In June, the statewide percentage of non-duals increase from 8.8% to 8.9%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased from 12.7% to 12.8%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 31.6% to 32.0%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased by 0.2% to 34.3%. Other Medicare Advantage decrease from 11.1% to 10.8%.

#### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan




#### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan


