


# Statewide Monthly Enrollments by MCO



Total CHC enrollment is 368,731, up from 366,631 in May.



### CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO






#### **CHC Market Share Chart**



#### May to June Changes



The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population with 62%, followed by HCBS with 25% of the population and then rounded out with LTC with 13% of the population.


The graphic to the left reflects the changes from May's market share by MCO to June's market share by MCO. It is important to note that all fluctuations are 1% or less and the minimal change between regions resulted in a net effect of no change at the statewide level.

### CHC Market Share by Population Group






#### Medicare Type for All CHC Recipients by Region


## Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan


### D-SNP Enrollee Trending Data by Plan


# Statewide LTSS Population & HCBS Percentage
