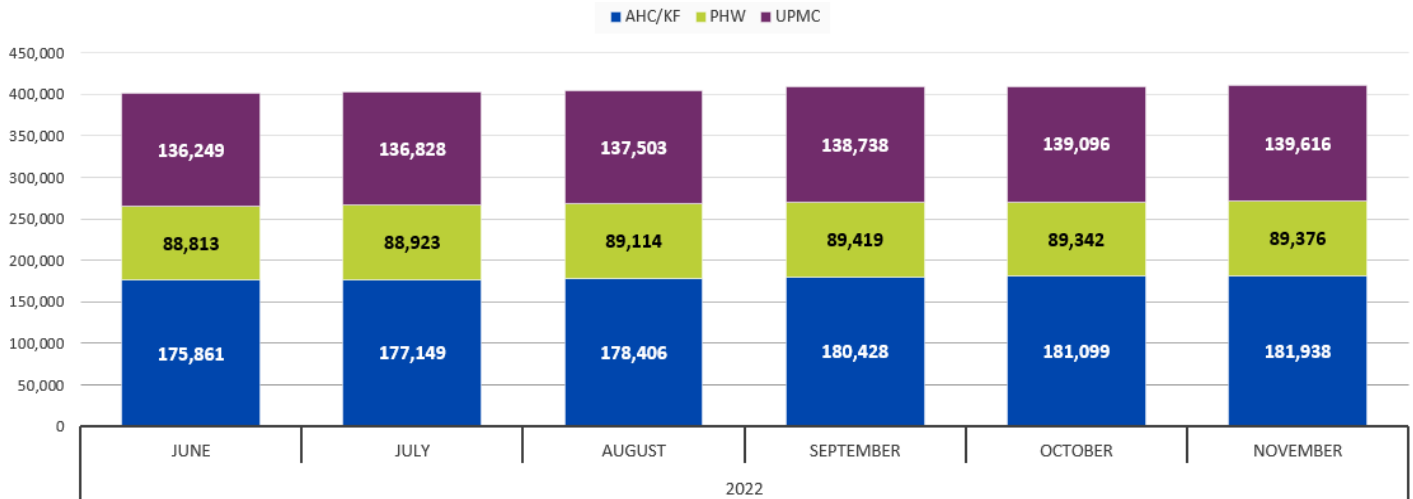

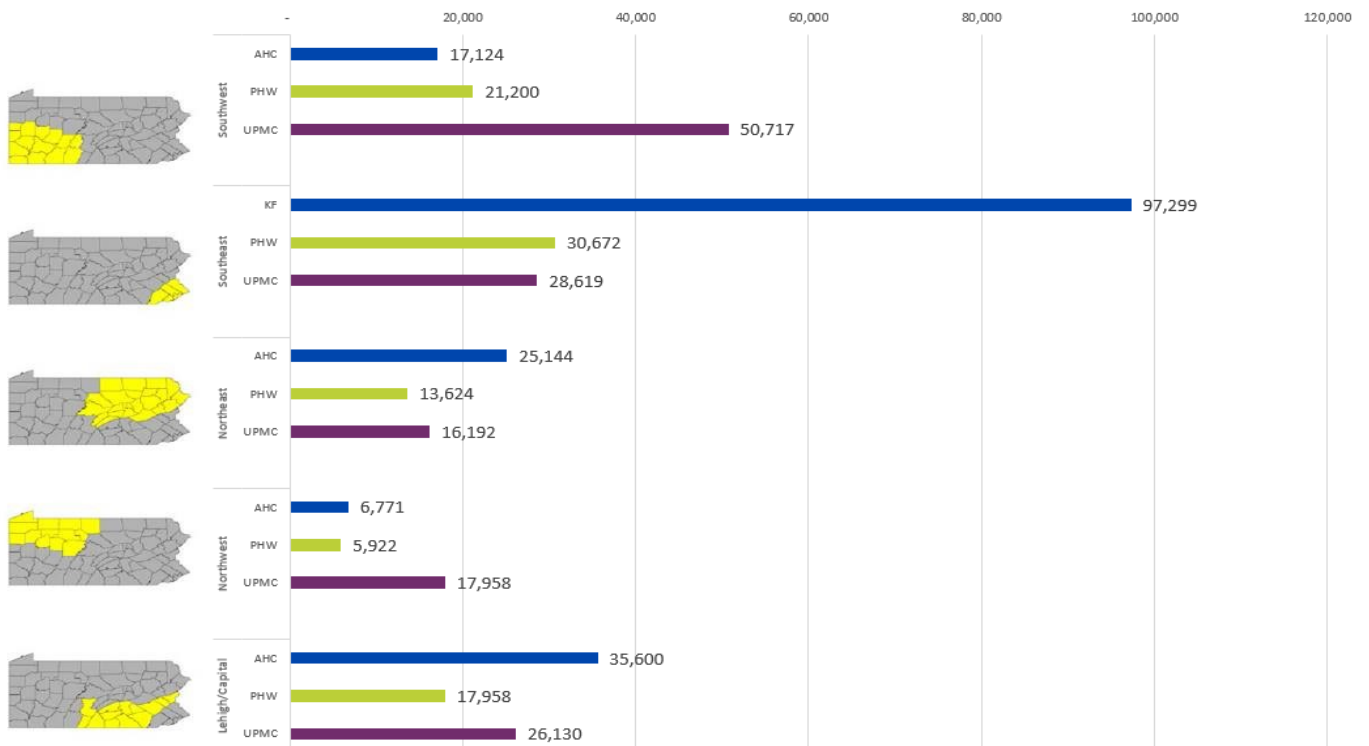
**CHC Statewide Enrollments Trends by MCO**

**CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO**

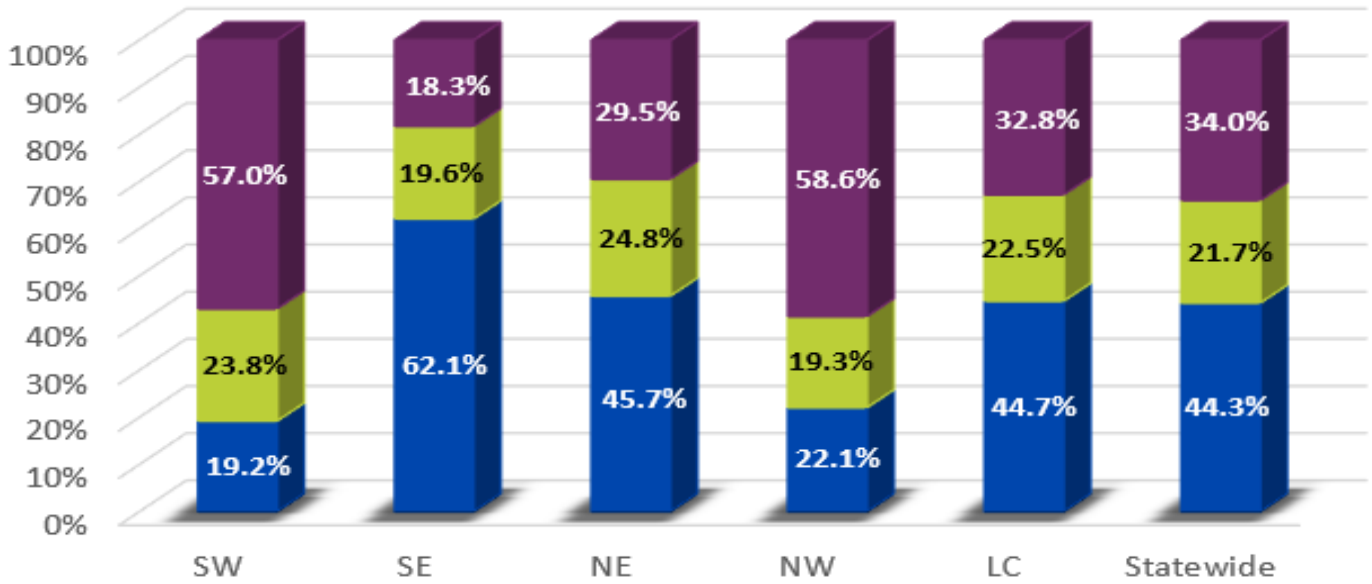

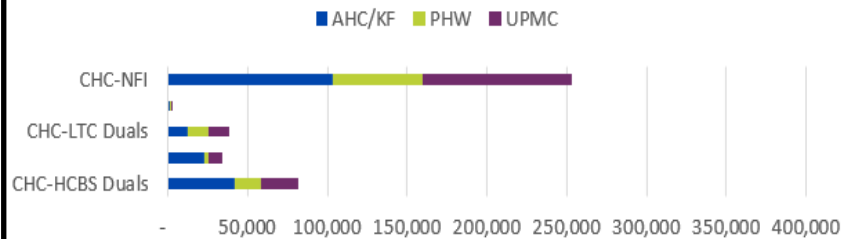

#### CHC Market Share by Population Group



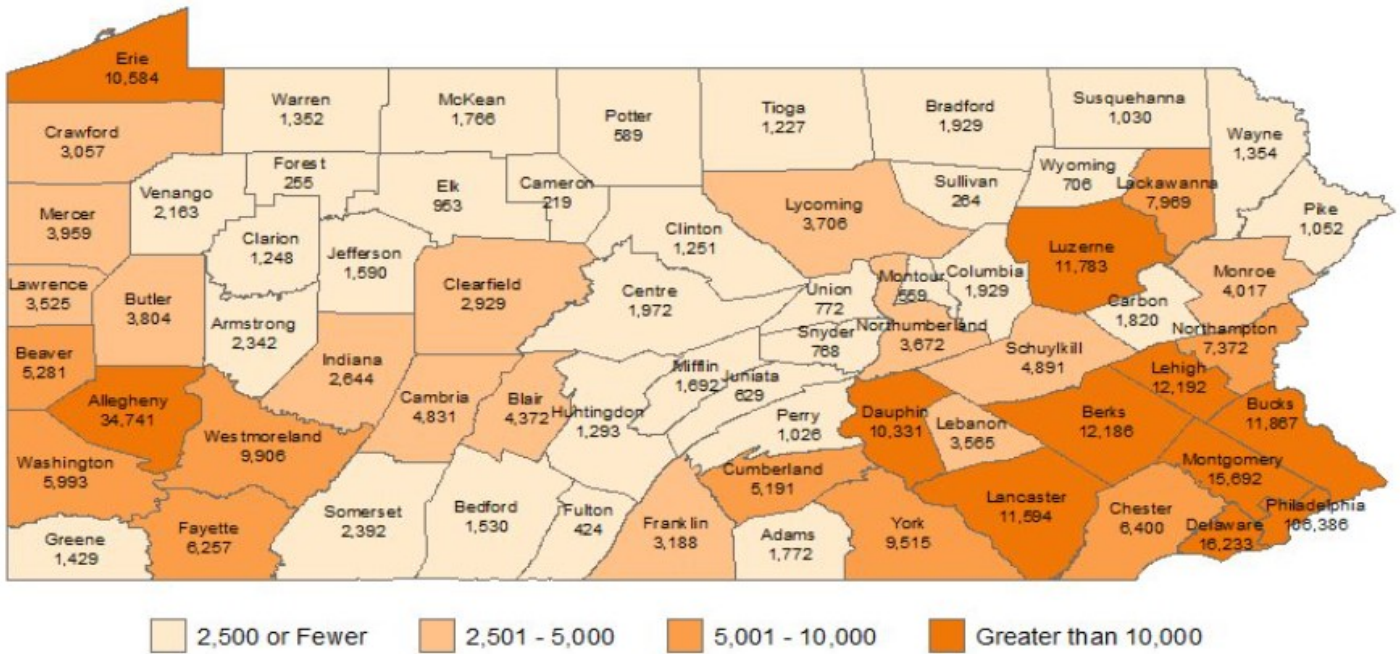

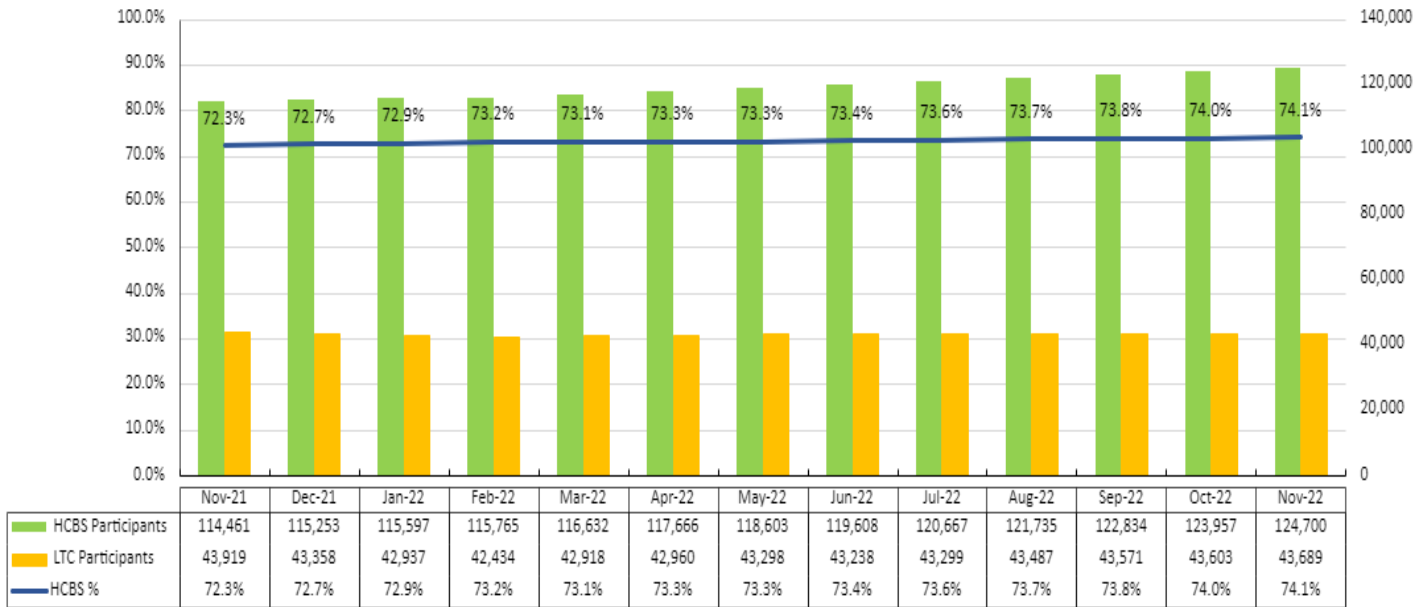
### CHC Enrollments by County\*

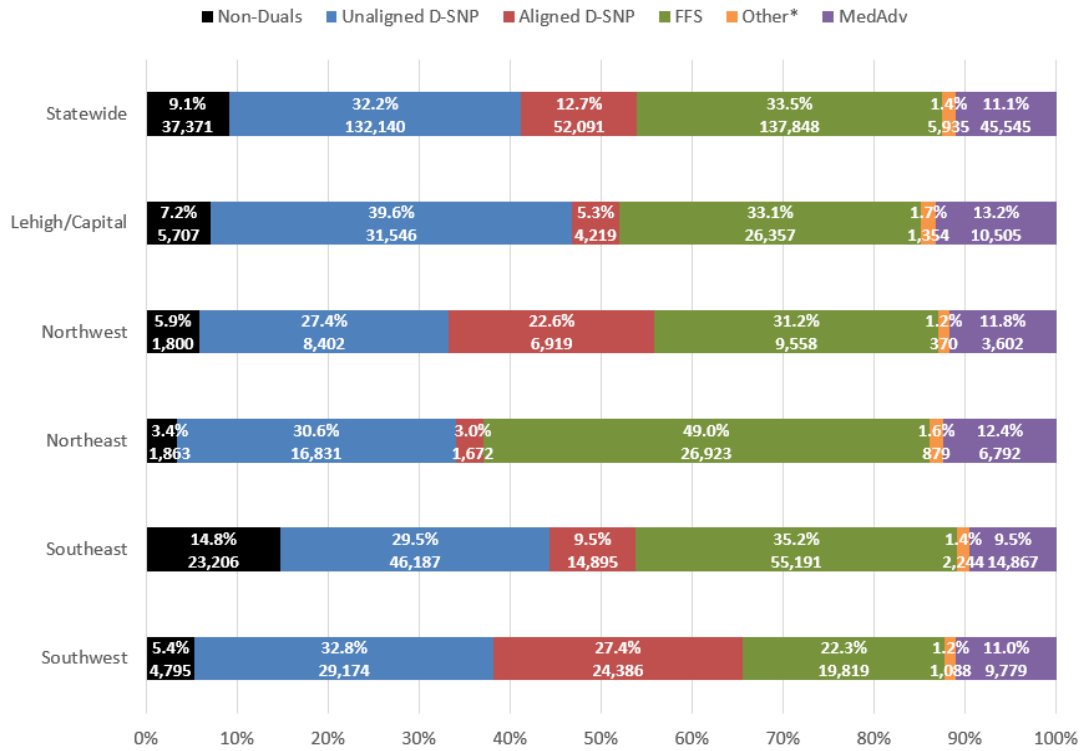
### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage

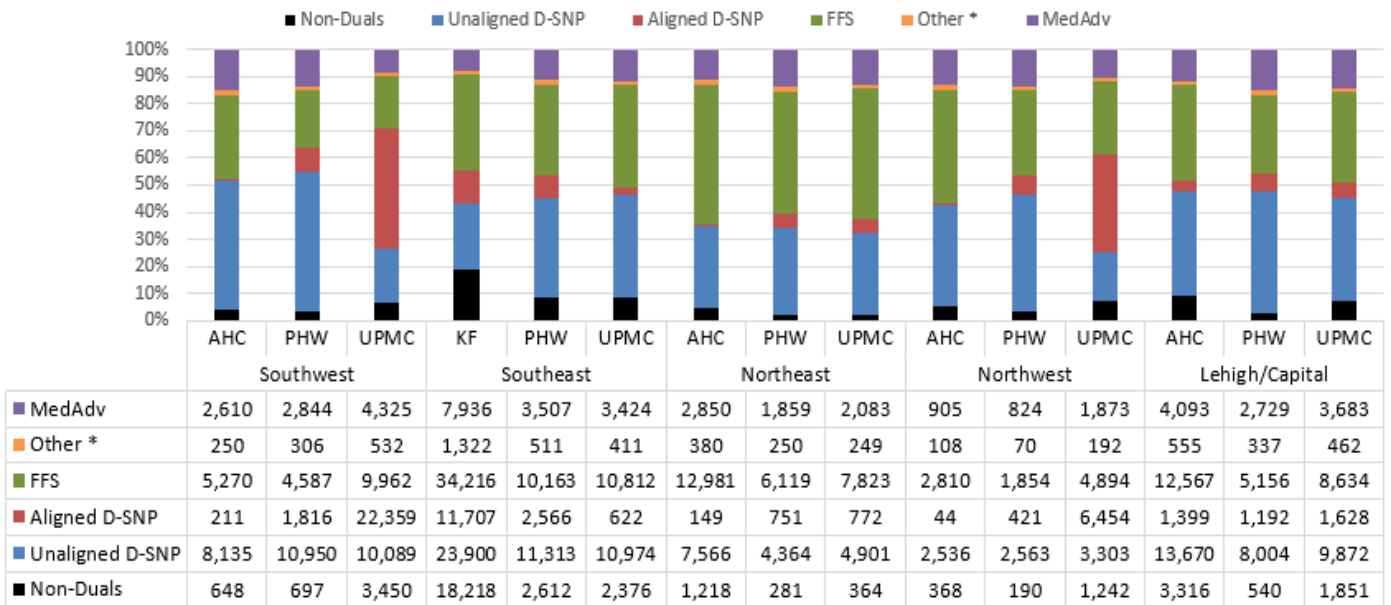
### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In November, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 9.1%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs decreased from 12.8% to 12.7%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs decreased from 32.5% to 32.2%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare remained the same at 33.5%. Other Medicare Advantage increased by 0.1% to 11.1%.

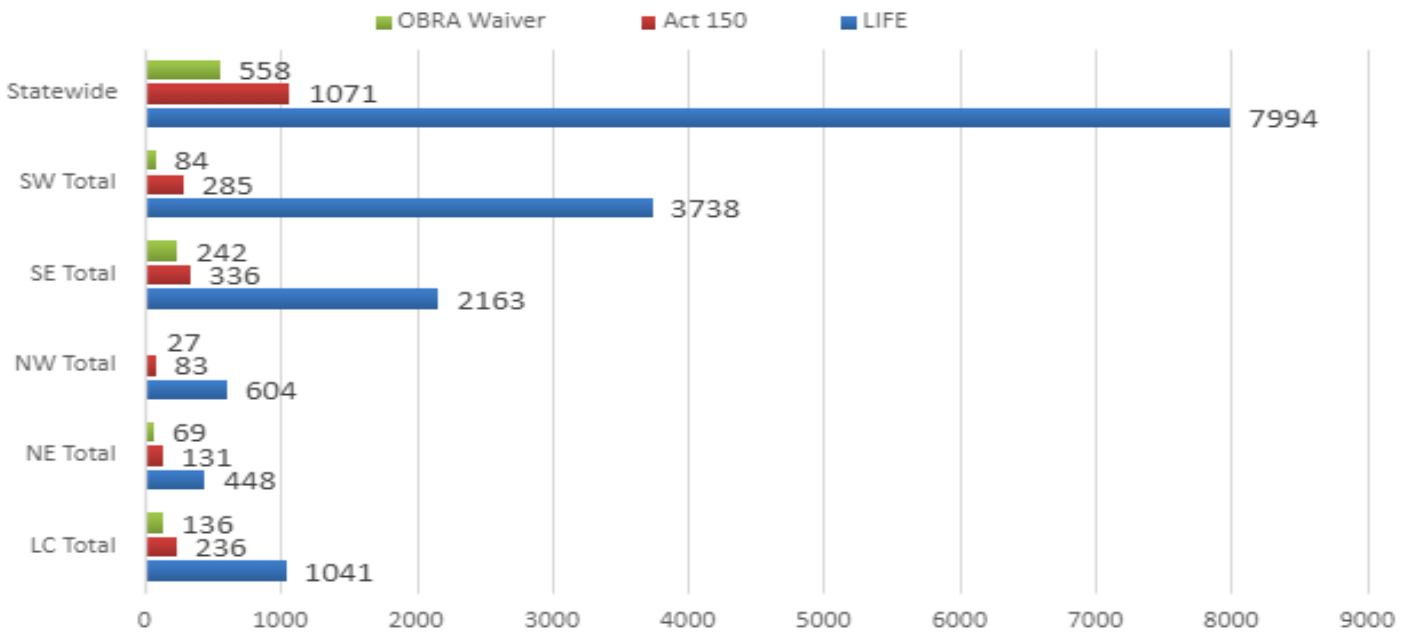

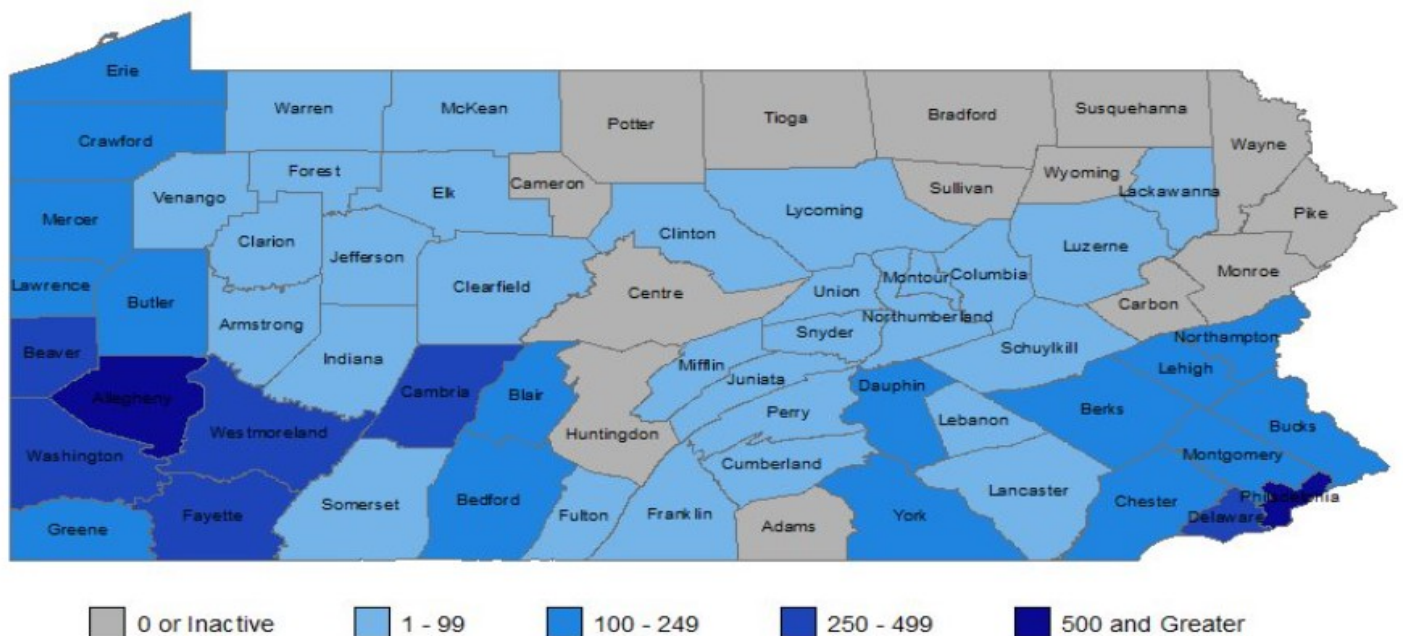
