








#### **CHC Market Share Chart**



The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 61.5%, this was a small decrease from November. The percentage of HCBS participants increased to 28.3% from 28.1% for the previous month. The LTC population had a slight decrease from the previous month of 10.3% to 10.2%.




#### CHC Enrollments by County\*

#### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage






#### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In December, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 9.1%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs decreased from 12.7% to 12.5%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs decreased from 32.2% to 31.5%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare increased from 33.5% to 33.7%. Other Medicare Advantage increased by 0.4% to 11.5%.


#### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan



#### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan



D-SNP participants have decreased 1.6% from November numbers. The overall enrollment numbers for 2022 has small increases month to month besides the previous two month, as depicted in the graph. We finished with a 9.3% increase for 2022.

#### Number of Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Facilities by County


