




CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO







CHC December to January Market Share Changes




The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 63.0%, representing a 0.4% increase from last month. The percentage of HCBS participants increased by 0.1% to 26.3% of the population and the LTC population decreased 0.5% to 10.7% of the population from December.




Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage



In January, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained at 8.3%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased from 10.8% to 11.5%, and the percentage of participants in un-aligned D-SNPs increased from 27.2% to 28.7%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased by 2.0% to 40.0%. Other Medicare Advantage decreased to 10.2% from 10.5%.


