

Pennsylvania Medicaid State Plan (PDF Format)

The basic construction of the SP contains three components or chapters: Table of Contents, Sections, and Attachments. Using an alpha-numeric prefix on the file names – 0000.A, 0000 - 0043, allowed us to order the chapters electronically mimicking the order from the Table of Contents. For example, file **0000.A_Read Me Pennsylvania Medicaid State Plan.pdf** is the “read me” file that contains this information; **0000.B Superseding Pages.pdf** (created in 2014) identifies the superseding pages; the Table of Contents is contained in file **0000_Table of Contents.pdf**; the contents of Section 1 is contained in file **0001_Section 1.pdf**; the contents of Section 6 is contained in file **0006_Section 6.pdf**; and the contents of Attachment 4.19A is in file **0024 Attachment 4.19A.pdf** etc.. There are 47 files.

You can read, print, and copy the file(s) of the State Plan, and perform text searches on it (either individual file searches within Adobe Reader or by searching every file with Adobe Reader). The State Plan contains pages as old as 1967 and were created on 20th Century technology – probably an IBM Selectric II typewriter – but were never upgraded with 21st Century technology. These PDF's are an attempt to bridge the gap.
