DexCom Continuous Glucose Monitoring Products Coverage

Continuous glucose monitoring (CGM) allows users to track their blood glucose (i.e., "blood sugar") levels throughout the day and night and in real time. Currently, CGM products are available through the Durable Medical Equipment (DME) benefits. Effective April 1, 2020,1) DexCom CGM products will also be covered under the pharmacy benefit for beneficiaries in the Fee-for-Service (i.e., ACCESS) delivery system and 2) prior authorization will not be required for DexCom products obtained through DME or pharmacy benefits unless quantity limits are exceeded. Claims for DexCom CGM products for Fee-for-Service beneficiaries should be billed as pharmacy claims using the standard NCPDP, 837 Professional, or internet formats.

^{*}The quantity billed for DexCom G5-G4 Sensor Kit and DexCom G6 Sensor should reflect the number of sensors dispensed (i.e., one DexCom G5-G4 Sensor Kit box should be billed as a quantity of 4 [4 sensors per box] and one DexCom G6 Sensor should be billed as a quantity of 3 [3 sensors per box]).
