Version 34 of All Patient Refined-Diagnosis Related Group (APR DRG) Implementation

The Department of Human Services (Department) will be implementing Version 34.0 of the APR DRG classification system on January 27, 2017 for Medical Assistance (MA) program enrolled acute care general hospitals that provide services to MA beneficiaries in the Fee-For-Service delivery system. This will affect acute care general inpatient stays with discharge dates on or after October 1, 2016. Below, you will find important tips regarding the transition to Version 34.0 of APR DRG:

Discharge dates:

Before January 27, 2017 – claims will process with the current APR DRG Version 33 classification system.

On or after January 27, 2017– claims will process with the Version 34(v34.0) APR DRG classification system.

New/Deleted/Revised APR DRG(s):

There are new, deleted, and revised APR DRGs for v34.0

Seven(7) New APR DRGs added

- ➤ 0695 CHEMOTHERAPY FOR ACUTE LEUKEMIA
- > 0696 OTHER CHEMOTHERAPY

Three(3) APR DRGs were deleted

- ▶ 0173 OTHER VASCULAR PROCEDURES
- > 0460 RENAL FAILURE
- ▶ 0693 CHEMOTHERAPY

Four(4) APR DRGs had description revisions

- > 162 CARDIAC VALUE WITH AMI OR COMPLEX PDX
- > 163 CARDIAC VALUE WITHOUT AMI OR COMPLEX PDX
- > 165 CORONARY BYPASS WITH AMI or COMPLEX PDX
- > 166 CORONARY BYPASS WITHOUT AMI or COMPLEX PDX





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New Procedure Codes:

There are 11 new procedure codes in the operating room list which will impact the APR DRG assignment (and SOI/ROM assignment where applicable). There are 5 new procedure codes in the non-operating room list which will still not affect the APR DRG, SOI, or ROM.
