- "A program, organization, or system that is trauma-informed:
- **Realizes** the widespread impact of trauma and understands potential paths for recovery;
- *Recognizes* the signs and symptoms of trauma in clients, families, staff, and others involved with the system;
- *Responds* by fully integrating knowledge about trauma into policies, procedures, and practices; and
- Seeks to actively resist re-traumatization."

- Cultural, Historical & Gender Issues




FINDING A NEW NORMAL

 Pulling the POSITIVE behavior patterns from the past and combining the new ones to blend into something that only the person can define as 'HEALTH.'



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
SOFT LANDING TRAUMA INFORMED RESETTLEMENT


